PRESENTATION OF VOUCHERS

The Board was presented with vouchers paid during the month of August 2017. These vouchers represented the normal day-to-day operating expenses, approved budgeted expenses and payroll. Mr. Lah stated he is pleased that the finance staff provides a very detailed accounting of monthly purchases.

BUDGET PROJECTIONS

John Oros presented a list of possible cost containment measures previously requested by the board. Mr. Lah asked about tuition reimbursement, training and certifications. Mr. Oros explained that the park expects to see an employee pursue education that applies to their career field within the park. He also said that training is occasionally attended for items that pertain to the employee's current position. Mr. Oros also presented possible revenue generation measures such as through fees and grants, and information regarding tire purchases for park vehicles along with a fleet inventory to the board. Mr. Lah said he supports training related to park career paths and requested a comparison of other parks fee structures for the next board meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

PLANNING & OPERATIONS UPDATE

Mr. Oros delivered an update to the Board on the status of construction projects including Claridon Woodlands and Maple Highlands Trail South paving. He said the rock wall and ropes course will be installed in September. Matt McCue added that some trail work is also being finished up. Mr. Lah inquired about what type of projects are worked on during winter. Mr. McCue stated that the construction crew focuses on tables, prefab and items for spring, snow removal, shelter and lodge items.

RESOLUTION NO. 9-17 - CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVIES

John Oros presented a request to approve amounts and rates determined by the budget commission to authorize the tax levies and certify them to the county auditor.
